Volunteer Reception Center Training

When disaster strikes, volunteers can help staff a center where community members can come to find the best place for them to help.

Before lending a hand, spontaneous volunteers that arrive to help must be interviewed and screened, matched with a specific volunteer opportunity, trained and fitted with a wristband at a Volunteer Reception Center (VRC) before they are sent back to the disaster scene.

Join United Way Volunteer Connection and other community leaders for training on how to be part of staffing a VRC. Help Marathon County be prepared if a large scale disaster strikes.
