Mascots – does your company or school have a mascot to entertain the crowd? Bring them to CommUnity Fest and give kids fun entertainment and photo ops.

- You may build any kind of sculpture. It can be as simple as your logo or as complicated as you wish. Building must take place during the setup hours.
- You may use other props or supporting materials, but your sculpture must be comprised of at least 50% non-perishable food or household goods.
- The booth space is 12x12, with walls on three sides. Each booth has electricity.
- Food items cannot be painted, taped or otherwise altered in a way that makes them unsuitable for donation.
- Someone from your team should be available at 1:45 pm on Saturday for the awards presentation and to assist with tear down of your sculpture.


Please remove any non-food or household items from the Expo Building by 4:00 pm. For safety reasons, please do not start tearing down your structure before 2:00 pm on Saturday.

Additional Guidelines for On the Spot Challenge:

 All teams in each level will receive the same food items. Your team must use all of the items and cannot add additional food or household products. You may use things like cardboard, plywood, tagboard, etc.

Children's Activities (both corporate with food drive and agency partner):

- Your booth will be 12x12 with walls on three sides. Electricity is available in each booth.
- You will receive one 8' table and 2 chairs with your registration.
- To avoid duplication of activities, please include your activity description with registration; you will
 receive confirmation that your activity is available.
